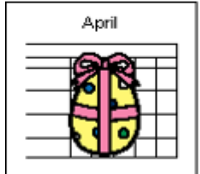

Greater Manchester Confirm and Challenge Group



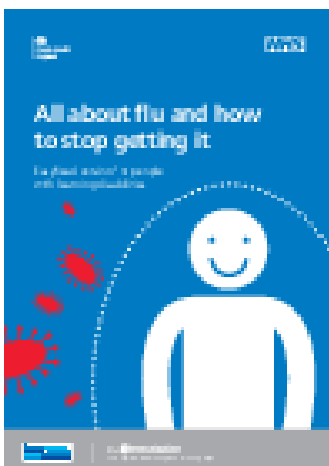
Last month we said that the group could choose a person to speak up for them, alongside Sean, at the 'Greater Manchester Confirm and Challenge' meetings.
